QUIT CLAIM DEED

LANGDON, his wife, peace of the consideration of One Dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and also of benefits to accrue to them by reason of laying out and establishing a public street or road through our property, and which is hereafter described, convey, release and quit-claim to THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON, a municipal corporation, in the County of Snohomish, State of Washington, for the use of the public forever, all interest in the following described real estate situated in Snohomish County, State of Washington, viz:

A 60 foot roadway across the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 11, and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 12, Township 31 North, Range 5 East. W.M., the centerline of which is described as:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Stillaguamish Avenue and the North line of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 5 East, W.M., which is a point on said North line 33.79 feet West of the northeast corner of said northeast quarter of southeast quarter of northeast quarter; thence south 305 feet more or less to a point 10 feet West and 305.42 feet south, as measured along the East line of said northeast quarter from the Northeast corner of said northeast quarter; thence South 3053:36" West 957.53 feet more or less to the Southeast corner of said northwest quarter of Section 11.
