EASEMENT AGREEMENT

The parties hereto are ARLINGTON CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 16, of Snohomish County, Washington, hereinafter called School, and the CITY OF ARLINGTON, Washington, hereinafter called City.

For and in consideration of the mutual covenants below, the parties agree as follows:

(1) School grants to City an Easement for the construction, maintenance, repair and replacement, if necessary, of a 4-inch AC water pipeline as part of City's municipal water system upon School's real property situate in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 5 East, W.M., Snohomish County, Washington, and running from the intersection of Stillaguamish and Maple Streets abutting on the east of said property, South from Maple Street, and West from Stillaguamish, all as set forth on the diagram attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein. Said easement shall extend perpetually from the date hereof, and City shall have all necessary rights of ingress and egress with respect to the maintenance and replacement of said pipeline, but shall not be required to maintain or replace the same.

(2) City shall furnish to school water service for irrigating the football playing field and its surrounding frounds for a monthly charge of \$12.00, monthly, and in consideration of City constructing said line, School shall pay the same.

The foregoing charge of \$12.00 per month for each of the 12 months in the calendar year shall continue for a period of years from the date of this agreement; provided, however,
