SEWER RIGHT-OF-WAY AND EASEMENT.

THIS INDENTURE made and entered into this day of June A.D., 1913, by and between the WISCONSIN TIMBER COMPANY, a corporation, party of the first part, and the TOWN OF ARLINGTON, a municipal corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the party of the first part, and for the further consideration of benefits to accrue to first party by reason of the construction of a sewer system in said town, the said first party hereby grants unto the said second party, and its successors, the right, so far as the first party's interest therein is concerned, to lay, construct and perpetually maintain a sewer across the following described real estate, situate in the county of Snohomish, state of Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Northerly line of Riverside Avenue as laid out in the original Town of Haller City, said point being North 71 degrees, no minutes West, a distance of 325 feet, more or less, from the intersection of the center line of alley between Cox and Haller Avenues with the center line of Minor Street, the above bearing based upon Minor Street, being considered as running in a due North and South direction; thence North 71 degrees and no minutes, West for a distance of 142 feet, more or less, to the low water line of the Stillaguamish River,

said sewer to be constructed at such depth below the surface of said land, that the use of the surface of said land above said sewer will not be interfered with, by reason of the existence or maintenance of said sewer.

less from any and all damage to said property that may be occasioned in whole or in part by the breaking of said sewer, or by reason of the failure of the party of the second part to properly maintain it. The party of the second part further covenants to and with the party of the first part, its successors and assigns that in laying said sewer across said property, it will not take any longer time than may be reasonably necessary therefor, and that upon said sewer being laid, it will restore the surface of the ground above the same to the condition in which it is now, as nearly as practicable.
